Dear Future 6th Graders,

The 6th grade teachers would like to officially welcome you to 6th grade! We have compiled a list of materials that we would like you to bring on the first day of school. You will need these materials all year long. **Most of these supplies must be replaced periodically throughout the school year!** Please, **NO TRAPPER KEEPERS**, as they do not fit well in the lockers.

Personal Items that may be used in more than one class and stored in your locker:

- 2 - boxes of #2 pencils
- 1 - set of fine-tipped markers (Crayola)
- 1 - set of colored pencils
- 1 - pencil pouch or bag
- 1 - plastic/vinyl, 2 pocket homework folder
- 1 pair earbud/headphone (not Bluetooth enabled)

Items that will go in labeled bins at Open House:

- Loose-leaf paper (wide ruled)
- 3 - boxes of tissues (1 for Essentials class)
- 4 - glue sticks
- 1 ream of copy paper

Items needed for core classes:

- 1 - composition notebook/journal (9.75 x 7.5") **ELA**
- 2- white 2-inch view-binder (clear front pocket on cover) **ELA, World Studies**
- 1- package of 8-tab dividers **ELA**
- 3 - highlighters (one pink, one yellow, one green) **ELA**
- 3 - packs of 3 x 3 sticky notes **ELA**
- 4 or more Scotch Disposable Tape Dispensers **ELA, Science**
- 3 - spiral-bound notebook **Math, Science, World Studies**
- 1 package of 4 dry erase markers (no neon colors) **Math**
- 1 basic calculator **Math**
- 2 fine tip EXPO markers **World Studies**
- 1 - 2 pocket plastic folder **Science**
- **PE:** Appropriate clothing (sweats/activity shorts, t-shirt, socks, tennis shoes)
- Tennis Shoes - mandatory for **PE, Woods, and Metals** classes

All personal items need to be marked with your name. Larger items definitely need to have your name on them, but even smaller items such as pencils last longer with your name.
